Installation Instructions

System Requirements

To successfully run StashWiz™, you will need a computer with the following minimum specifications:

Processor:	1.5ghz Celeron
Memory:	512mb RAM, 2048mb recommended
Disk Space:	500mb – 1gigabyte depending upon system needs
Graphics:	Middle to high-end graphics card recommended, lower end models will run the program slowly

In addition, your computer should be, ideally, no older than 5 years. Older computers will run this software very slowly.

We've tested StashWiz™ with the above configuration and while it worked, we wouldn't recommend it unless you haven't a choice.

NOTE: BE SURE TO READ THE ENTIRE USER GUIDE FOUND IN THE INSTALLATION DIRECTORY. It contains useful information about the proper use of the program.

IMPORTANT: If you have "Microsoft .NET Framework 3.5" or "Microsoft .NET Framework 3.5 SP1" you will need to uninstall that, then run our installation, then reinstall the .NET framework (you should install the SP1 update). This is a known issue in InstallShield and is not addressed as yet. We apologize for the inconvenience caused.

Installation Instructions – Windows XP

1. Insert the CD into your CD-ROM drive.
2. The setup program should start automatically. If it does not start automatically, choose **Start**, then **Run**. Click on **Browse** and locate the CD drive that contains StashWiz™. Double-click on Setup.exe, or, choose Setup.exe and click **Open**. You should now be back at the Run screen. Click **OK** to run the selected file.
3. Depending upon your system, you may receive the latest version of Windows Installer, and/or the .NET Framework version 3.5. Both things do take some time to install, so please be patient, as it may appear as if nothing is going on. You will probably need to reboot your computer after the .NET Framework 3.5 is installed. **NOTE:** If you see a blank list (appearing as though there is nothing to install), click the "install" button anyway. This is a "bug" in the installer and will not affect the installation of StashWiz™.
4. After reboot, or if you have already have the pre-requisites in Step 3, the setup program will restart and begin to install StashWiz™. Simply follow the prompts. The only option you have is to change where StashWiz™ is installed. You are welcome to do so when the setup program asks you to verify the installation location. **NOTE:** Just prior to the installation of StashWiz™, Microsoft's Access 2007 Database Engine installer will execute. Follow the prompts on the screens to install it.
5. Once StashWiz™ is installed, you may leave the "Launch StashWiz.exe" checkbox checked and execute the program.

Installation Instructions – Windows Vista

1. NOTE TO VISTA USERS: You **must** be an Administrator, or have Administrative privileges, to run the setup program. If you do not have appropriate permissions, an error will occur.
2. Insert the CD into your CD-ROM drive.
3. The setup program may start automatically. If it does, exit the program as you cannot install StashWiz™ in this manner.
4. Click the **Start Orb**, then **Computer**. Locate the CD drive that contains StashWiz™.
5. Open the CD drive and find the **Setup.exe** program. Right-click on **Setup.exe**, then choose **Run as Administrator**. The setup program will then execute.
6. Depending upon your system, you may need to receive the latest version of Windows Installer, and/or the .NET Framework version 3.5. Both things do take some time to install, so please be patient, as it may appear as if nothing is going on. You will see an initial screen containing these pre-requisites. Click the Install button at the bottom of the screen. You will probably need to reboot your computer after the .NET Framework 3.5 is installed. **NOTE:** If you see a blank list (appearing as though there is nothing to install), click the “install” button anyway. This is a “bug” in the installer and will not affect the installation of StashWiz™.
7. After reboot, or if you have already have the pre-requisites in Step 3, the setup program will restart and begin to install StashWiz™. Simply follow the prompts. The only option you have is to change where StashWiz™ is installed. You are welcome to do so when the setup program asks you to verify the installation location. **NOTE:** Just prior to the installation of StashWiz™, Microsoft’s Access 2007 Database Engine installer will execute. Follow the prompts on the screens to install it.

If the StashWiz™ installation does not restart after the .NET Framework and/or updated Windows installer are installed, simply proceed from Step 4 above.

8. Once StashWiz™ is installed, uncheck the “Launch StashWiz.exe” checkbox and exit the setup program.
9. You should be back at the explorer window showing the directory containing the installation files for StashWiz™. If not, open your **Computer** explorer window as described in Step 4, but don’t browse to the CD drive. Instead, you will need to browse to the folder where you installed StashWiz™. This folder, if you installed the program to the default directory, would be located at: C:\Program Files\JTA Enterprises LLC\StashWiz.
10. Right-click on that folder. Using the example in Step 9, you would right-click on StashWiz.
11. Choose **Properties**.
12. Click the **Security** tab.
13. Click **Edit**. You will probably get the UAC (User Account Control) message asking for permission to modify the folder settings.
14. Select the **Users** group and then check the **Full Control** checkbox under the **Allow** column.
15. Click **Apply**, then click **OK**.
16. Click **OK** one more time on the StashWiz properties screen.
17. You can close your Computer explorer window if you wish.
18. Now you can double-click the StashWiz™ icon on the desktop to start StashWiz™.
